## **Changes to country yellow fever certificate requirements during outbreaks**

### **Important reminder to check for updates to country yellow fever certificate requirements**

During yellow fever outbreaks, travellers and health professionals are reminded that countries may change their yellow fever certificate requirements at short notice.

We have recently found notices regarding changes to the certificate requirements for [Panama](#) and [Nicaragua](#) in response to the yellow fever outbreak in Brazil. This information may not be reflected in the World Health Organization (WHO) publication International Travel and Health.
